My name is Dougie Mackie, I'm 34 originally from New Zealand and have been working as a self-shooting video director and editor here in London for the past 8 years. Filming the likes of **Rihanna, Michael Bublé, Wretch 32, Josh Groban, Usher, Pink, Tulisa** and more.

I became aware of Bauer years ago prior to my filmmaking career when I worked in Radio as an Announcer and Music Director for **Mediaworks** New Zealand, so I understand today as a filmmaker how mammoth this position is and the potential it holds. Red carpet you say? I've shot many interviews and directed other camera operators along side to create news cuts and promo virals for fast turn around press content. My most recent release was for the Kinky Boots Opening Night which you can view on my website.

Im extremely tech and gadget savvy and am very much a narrative driven filmmaker, always looking and listening for the story and shooting the edit as it happens.

Though I think the biggest strength I will bring to Bauer Media is my relaxed, yet determined and enthusiastic kiwi personality, along with my years of experience within the industry. I find this puts crew, clients, colleagues and interviewee's at ease, which translates into content that is fun and engaging for audiences.
